RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Authorizing the Corporation for Public Broadcasting's 5 Blanket Music Licensing Agreements and a Limited Waiver of Sovereign Immunity)

RESOLUTION NO. 24-157

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") vests the Legislative
2		Council with the power "to consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and
3		contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with private persons or
4		organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham
5		Council" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
6	WHEREAS,	KOHN FM is a non-commercial terrestrial radio broadcast station licensed to the
7		Nation and is a qualified public radio station able to receive funding from the
8		Corporation for Public Broadcasting ("CPB"); and
9	WHEREAS,	KOHN FM's signal only reaches some areas within the exterior boundaries of the
10		Nation and the Nation has long desired to provide the broadcast programming of
11		KOHN FM to all of its members within and beyond its exterior boundaries; and
12	WHEREAS,	in previous years, CPB, on behalf of public radio stations, has negotiated and
13		executed a Public Radio Webcasting License Agreement with SoundExchange;
14		Inc., with the previous term from January 1, 2014, through December 31, 2020,
15		which Agreement was approved by resolution 16-013; and
16	WHEREAS,	CPB, on behalf of public radio stations, has successfully re-negotiated and
17		executed 5 blanket music licensing agreements ("Agreements") with The Harry
18		Fox Agency; the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers
19		("ASCAP"); Broadcast Music Inc. ("BMI"); Global Music Rights LLC ("GMR"); and
20		SESACLLConbehalfofpublicbroadcastingsystem, forthetermofJanuary1, 2023
21		through December 31, 2027; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Agreements provide that CPB will pay the license fees for all Covered Entities
23		so as to permit them to make public performances of sound recordings by means
24		of digital audio transmissions through one or more authorized websites; and
25	WHEREAS,	a Covered Entity is defined as an eligible Originating Public Radio Station which
26		is a noncommercial terrestrial radio broadcast station that i) is licensed as such
27		by the Federal Communications Commissions; ii) originates programming and is
28		not solely a repeater station; iii) is a member or affiliate of National Public Radio,
29		American Public Media, Public Radio International, or Public Radio Exchange, a
30		member of the National Federation of Community Broadcasters, or another
31		public radio station that is qualified to receive funding from the Corporation for
32		Public Broadcasting pursuant to its criteria; and

(Authorizing the Corporation for Public Broadcasting's 5 Blanket Music Licensing Agreements and a Limited Waiver of Sovereign Immunity) Page 2 of 3 KOHN FM is a noncommercial terrestrial radio broadcast station licensed to the 1 WHEREAS. 2 Nation, and a qualified public radio station receiving funding from the CPB, 3 which meets the definition of a Covered Entity as defined in the Agreements; and paragraph 11.7 of the Agreement with the ASCAP requires that a Dispute 4 WHEREAS. 5 Resolution Procedure he incorporated to allow the parties to resolve disputes in accordance with the Commercial Mediation Procedures of the American 6 7 Arhitration Association, mediation shall take place in New York, New York; and 8 WHEREAS. paragraphs 16 of the Agreements with SESAC LLC and GMR LLC and paragraph 9 11.8 of the Agreement with the ASCAP require that the Agreement be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York: and 10 paragraph 13 of the Agreement with BMI requires that the Agreement be 11 WHEREAS. 12 governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York, that 13 the New York state and federal courts shall have sole jurisdiction on any 14 controversies regarding the Agreement; and 15 WHEREAS, the Legislative Cultural Preservation Committee has reviewed a limited waiver of the Nation's sovereign immunity in accordance with, and subject to the 16 17 limitations of each of the 5 Agreements; and 18 WHEREAS. the interests of the Nation will be served by the Legislative Council approving a 19 limited waiver of the Nation's sovereign immunity in accordance with, and 20 subject to the limitations of, the terms of the 5 Agreements. 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby grants 22 a limited waiver of sovereign immunity of the Nation, in accordance with, and 23 subject to the limitations of, the terms of the 5 Agreements for the period of 24 January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2027. 25 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the 5 blanket licensing Agreements, as attached and 26 incorporated into this resolution, is hereby approved and accepted and that the 27 Chairman or designated official is authorized to execute the agreement. 28 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD 29 day of IUNE 2024 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,071.5 FOR: -0-30 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 191.8 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council 31 by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the 32 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant 33 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 34 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
