5		authorized by resolution or ordinance (Const. of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Art.
6		VI, §§ 1(d)(2), (3)); and
7	WHEREAS,	on July 14, 2023, Legislative Council approved Res. No. 23-263, thereby accepting
8		U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Tribal Wildlife Grant No. F22AP01262-00, which
9		allocated \$200,000.00 to the Tohono O'odham Department of Natural Resources
10		Wildlife and Vegetation Management Program to study the distributional ecology
11		of medium and large mammals ("Project"); and
12	WHEREAS,	the purpose of the Project is to guide management and conservation practices for
13		the Nation's lands and threatened and endangered species by collecting and
14		analyzing data on wildlife communities, wildlife-habitat relationships, and
15		threats to wildlife; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation Wildlife and Vegetation Management Program
17		requests the Project's budget term under Res. No. 23-263, which expired on Feb.
18		29th, 2024, be extended through FY 2026; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Rudget and Finance Committees
20		have reviewed the amended budget to extend the Project's budget through FY
21		2026 and recommend its approval.
22	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves
23		budget term extension for FY 2026 for the Tohono O'odham Department of
24		Natural Resources Wildlife and Vegetation Management Program to study the
25		distributional ecology of medium and large mammals.
26	BE IT FINALI	LY RESOLVED by the Tobono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tobono O'odham
27		Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
28		expend these funds for the period of March 1, 2022 to February 29, 2026, provided
29		that any amendments or modifications shall first be submitted for approval by
30		the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
