2		the authority to "authorize, charter and regulate public or private corporations
3		and associations" and to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace,
4		morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its
5		members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and 1(e)); and
6	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 04-103, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopted the
7		Charter for the Community Development Financial Institution of the Tohono
8		O'odham Nation, establishing the Community Development Financial Institution
9		("CDFI") as an enterprise of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the CDFI Board of
10		Directors ("CDFI Board") (Charter of the Community Development Financial
11		Institution, 10 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 2) ("CDFI Charter"); and
12	WHEREAS,	the CDFI Charter requires that an independent certified public accountant audit
13		CDFI's accounts and records annually but does not set a deadline for providing
14		the audit report to the Nation; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee recommends amending subsection 5.4.17. of the CDFI
16		Charter to require the CDFI Board to submit an annual report and audit within
17		120 days of the close of the CDFI's fiscal year as follows:
18		5.4.17. Make annual reports regarding the CDFI's operations, finances and
19		budget, and present CDFI's annual audit, to the chairperson of the Nation and
20	i i	to the Legislative Council within 120 days of the close of the CDFI's fiscal year.
21	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council amends
22		subsection 5.4.17. of the Community Development Financial Institution Charter
23		in accordance with this Resolution.
